
## Welcome to the Landings!




Use of the **privately available** elements of the website follow below:

**REGISTRATION** - Use these instructions to register for the first time




If you do not already hold an account on the Landings HOA website, you may register on-line by selecting the registration link as shown above. This action will bring up a simple registration form as shown below. The form says register to vote, but it applies to all residents, regardless of lot ownership. Those renting properties will, however, be unable to vote.




## **LOGIN** – Once your registration has been approved, you may login


Merely complete the simple form and submit it by hitting the highlighted submit button. The HOA will review the registration, verifying that you are indeed a Landings resident and approve your registration. Once registered, you may login with the email based UserID and password you gave entered as shown below.



Should you eventually lose track of your password, you may reset it online by requesting an email which contains instructions for changing your forgotten password.



Once logged in, you gain access to the voting system, presuming it is active as well as a wide variety of data useful to residents of the Landings. The pull down menu for member data opens number of options to learn about how your HOA serves you and shares concern for your safety, your privacy and your rights as a resident of out community



For example, here: 1) you may find an up to date directory of friends and neighbors, 2) You may search for individuals, by name, spouse's name, HOA role, lot t number, slip number and RV lot assignment, 3) You may perform a search for service providers your neighbors endorse, 4) You may endorse a service provider, 5) You may review rules and regulations carefully designed to protect you and your family, 6) You may review the minutes of your HOA Board of Directors and 7) You may review pertinent budgetary documents.
